## 1967 Shelby GT500 Mustang

[Revell #1522; 1/25th scale; metal body]

Not too long ago the only model available of a 1967 Shelby Mustang was the Mini Exotics resin conversion kit for the old AMT 1968 Shelby GT500 kit. Then came the GT350 kit from AMT based on the standard 1967 Mustang kit. Hot Wheels came out with a diecast of a GT500 in a non-factory metallic blue color. It was a bit pricey at first, but like many of the Hot Wheels collector series, the market was soon flooded with new in the box examples for as little as \$40 on eBay. A cross between the AMT kit and the Hot Wheels diecast is the new Revell 1967 GT500 metal. body kit in 1/25th scale.

The *heavy body* is painted a very nice Brittany Blue with white stripes. The noticeable differences in this version are the lack of side and rear view mirrors. Also, the wheels in the kit are the ten spokers usually associated with the 1968 Shelbys.

The magstars in the AMT kit are very nice, and can be modified to fit this kit. The *rear shocks* are also *missing*, and the tail lights lack realistic detail.

The kit builds up very easily, and the 17-piece 428 Cobra Jet engine is comparable to those in full kits. Very little extra detail is needed to the body, and the interior can be left mostly black. There are decals for the aluminum finish door panels and rear paneling, but due to the ribbed surface, I just ended up painting those areas. A nice feature are the decals for the "OK" paint stamp on the engine heads, an emission decal

for the shock tower, a Carroll Shelby "signature" for placement on the chrome oval air cleaner, and a script for the radiator hose. Another nice touch is the *hood* latch catch that is usually overlooked in the engine compartment. With a few parts from the AMT kit, this model can be proudly displayed and built in just a few days. The color choice is a limiting factor but given the room 1/18th scale diecasts take up in ones collection, this kit gives one a sense of having built a model the way you like it. I would buy one of every year (1965-1970) and color if Revell makes them, as this kit has more detail than most ERTL 1/18th scale diecasts have, and is less expensive. Maybe a version with a Carroll Shelby figure will follow, ala the Bullitt and Vanishing Point kits? 🚔





#### This 'N That!

Neiman Marcus Christmas 'wish book'! That's where you'll find the first 101 Cadillac XLRs off the line! The special-edition road-



sters—dubbed NM XLR Edition come loaded with options, as well as a special trim, numbered sill plate and Ultra Violet paint. The XLR is the latest in a string of vehicles that Neiman Marcus has sold through its catalog, including a 1998 Audi TT and 2000 Ford Thunderbird. The XLR price tag rings in at \$85,000. A \$7,500 deposit is due at an authorized dealer upon receiving a tracking number. To get a tracking number, you'll have to be quick. Neiman Marcus starts taking orders Oct. 15 at 9 a.m. Pacific time. The first 99 qualified callers get dibs (the other two NM XLRs go to charity). The XLR rolls off assembly lines in April and buyers will have to wait until the summer to take actual delivery when the vehicle hits dealer lots....Nissan North America auctioned the first 2003 350Z, with vehicle identification No. 0000001, on e-Bay Motors the end of August. The bidding war for the Track Model 350Z with silver exterior and carbon-colored interior started at \$30,000, and increased in \$100 increments. The vehicle stickered at finalized to have \$37,513, had a six-speed manual and navigation. The bidding took place on ebaymotors.com. Nissan closed bidding for the vehicle August 29, and the highest bidder was to be flown to Los Angeles to

Helmut Panke, BMW's chairman, said earlier this week at a lunch in Detroit that the automaker sees Mini as filling an important niche below its forthcoming 1 Series and that "additional derivatives to expand the Mini brand are under discussion."....The officers of the Cunningham Motor Co. are preparing to ask Wall Street for as much as \$85 million to produce their first salable car. Robert Lutz, chairman of GM North America and founder of Cunningham Motor, plans to increase his investment to as much as \$2.5 million to help persuade investors to fund production of the proposed \$250,000 superluxury

website reported that Ford raised \$3.8 million dollars for charity. The Ghia Focus (unveiled in 1992), sold for \$1 million dollars. Other sales include: 1997 Mercury MC4 (\$580,000), 1995 Lincoln Sentinel (\$40,000), 1993 Lagonda Vignale (\$360,000), 1992 Mustang Mach III (\$440,000), and the 1983 Mini Max (\$4,500) ....Remember the Guldstrand Corvette from the July issue? Well, recalling the glory days of

huge big-block horsepower and torque, Dick Guldstrand announced that his Signature Edition Anniversary Corvette will be powered by a

new generation 500-horsepower 427 V8. The engine used in the Guldstrand Signature Edition Corvette is built by Katech, Inc. (they also produce engines for the Corvette C5-R race cars that won at LeMans in 2001 and 2002, as well as every American LeMans Series race so far this year!). 



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

## Corvette Thunder

As part of celebrating the Corvette's 50th anniversary, Dick **Guldstrand** is publishing what promises to be the definitive history book on Corvette racing. Entitled "Corvette Thunder, 50 Years of Corvette Racing," the book covers the car's racing successes. "Racing made the Corvette into a world-class sports car," says Guldstrand, "and this book will show how it happened and those who made it happen." Written by noted automotive historian *Dave Friedman*, the book tells a story full of plot twists and shenanigans, featuring some of the most famed characters who ever walked pit road. Friedman has searched archives from around the world, and come up with a treasure trove of material. "The book will have hundreds and previously unpublished photos," Friedman says, "plus many unknown stories and even some historical surprises. We plan to make the book as complete and up to date as possible for the Corvette's 50th anniversary, covering everything from the early days of the famous Mexican Road Race up to and including the 2003 Sebring 12 Hours." Scheduled for release in December, the book is a 400-page hardbound book with 650 photos, and is priced at \$75. A special pre-publication offer allows enthusiasts to reserve a copy of this collectible book for \$60. #### Croozer Alert!

Chrysler's newest *limited-production PT Cruiser* is slated to hit the market in January. The vehicle was debuted by Chrysler in advance of Detroit's annual *Woodward Dream Cruise*, which took place August 17.

Dubbed Dream Cruiser 2, this 2003 PT's exterior is painted in a metallic tangerine orange headto-toe, with the orange theme extending to the interior with a pair of partial orange seats, orange panels on the doors and bodycolored fascia over the gauge bezel and passenger airbag door. The vehicle is much like the gold 2002 Dream Cruiser Chrysler debuted last year, however this version has a *spoiler* planted above the tailgate and chrome moldings beneath the door. Chrome also covers the gas and brake pedals. the shifter shaft and door lock knobs.

Dream Cruiser goes on sale in January as a 2003 model and will sticker for \$26,475 for a manual and \$26,915 for the auto-manual, which is a far cry from the base PT Cruiser's current \$17,000 base sticker. Part of the price bump comes from the car's turbo-charged 215-hp 2.4-liter four-cylinder mill, in addition to all the aesthetic goodies. The vehicle also comes standard with Sirius satellite radio.

Chrysler will produce 9,500 Dream Cruiser 2s, with 7,500 of those units earmarked for North American markets. Elsewhere, the vehicle will be called *Chrysler PT Street Cruiser Series 2*.


## BIG Wings!








## **Directions**

From the Baltimore Beltway (RT 695): Take Exit 7, Route 295

(Baltimore-Washington Parkway) south towards Washington approx. 18 miles to Route 193 (Greenbelt Road), and exit. When on the offramp, stay to the right and merge right onto Southway (see below).

From the Washington Beltway (RT 495): Take Exit 22 north, towards Baltimore. Stay in the right lane and take the first exit onto Route 193 (Greenbelt Road). When on the off-ramp, bear to the right and take Greenbelt road west, towards College Park. Stay in the right lane and immediately after passing over the Parkway, make a right (at the light) onto Southway (read on!)



Once on Southway: Go straight to the second (2nd) STOP sign.

Make a left onto Crescent road. Go to the STOP sign and make a right into the parking lot behind the Greenbelt Library. Once in parking lot, look to the right. The large, white building is the Greenbelt Community Center. Enter building using the doors near fenced tot lot. The multi-purpose room is on the second floor. There is an elevator to the left of the entrance.
