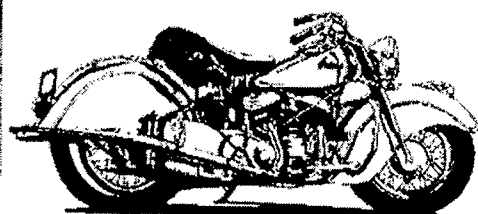

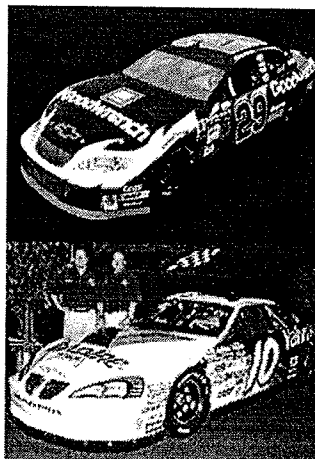
## This 'N That!

**Kudos! MAMA's Boy Ron 'Mr. Mopar' Dreschler** wowed 'em at a recent IPMS model show, and was rewarded with First and Second place awards, and an Honorable Mention. *Waytogo, Ron!*....And while on the subject of *Mopar*, remember back in the July newsletter, when I reported on the *Dodge Viper vs. the USAF's Lockheed Martin F-16 Viper*, but couldn't tell you who won? Well, the "*Ripley's Believe it or Not*" episode was repeated recently, and to no one's surprise, the *Dodge* won the *quarter mile contest*, while the *Air Force Viper 'sucked' the Dodge up its jet exhaust in the half-mile competition!*....And, while on the subject of *Dodge's 'King Snake'*, looks like the honchos at Dodge have screwed their dealers on the entire run of **1,500 2003 Vipers!** Dodge reportedly *pre-sold the entire run of 2003 Vipers* by giving existing owners exclusive rights to buy them!! These certificates were reportedly gobbled up in *less than two weeks!* This has hammered down transaction prices for the redesigned Viper by creating a closed, buyer's market for the supercar. Because buyers know that dealers can't sell to anyone not holding an official certificate, many are demanding prices barely over dealer invoice for a car that typically would generate at least a **\$7,000 profit. Oops!**....*NASCAR* has ap-



proved the *body templates* for both the *2003 Monte Carlo* and *Grand Prix* for next year's season. *Hendrick Motorsports, Joe Gibbs Racing, Dale Earnhardt Inc. and Richard Childress Racing* all helped develop the Chevy.... *Briggs Cunningham III vs. Bob Lutz! Briggs Cunningham III is suing Bob Lutz and GM*, claiming that he was forced to sell his stock back to the company at a rock-bottom price to pay off a **\$750,000 dollar** loan used for start-up capital. They were intent on raising **\$85 million** so that *Cunningham Motor* could produce the *Cunningham C7 luxury sports car*....*Hot Rod SUVs (a.k. a. Simply Useless Vehicles!)* ??? *General Motors* is strongly considering *high-performance versions*

of its *popular mid-sized sport-utilities*. The company also is making progress on a plan to produce a *roadster* for *Pontiac*. GM will show several high-performance concept vehicles at the *Specialty Equipment Market Association show* in November in Las Vegas. GM also is likely to display the high-performance sport-utilities at the Detroit auto show in January. GM is "*very, very interested*" in making the mid-sized sport-utilities - the *Chevrolet TrailBlazer, GMC Envoy, Oldsmobile Bravada* and the future *Buick Rainier* - part of its



performance-vehicle program. Upgrades will include *turbocharged engines* and *special handling packages*. GM's SEMA lineup will focus on trucks and entry-level vehicles, especially in building credibility for four-cylinder engines among "tuner" enthusiasts. "*We want to get performance into the small car for GM,*" he said. GM also has a tentative plan for a

rear-wheel-drive architecture for the *Pontiac Solstice concept roadster*. GM has been searching for the right architecture for the car, which was unveiled at the Detroit show this year....*GM* has inked a four-year deal to supply **48 modified vehicles** (racing-type wheels, a roll bar, racing decals, racing seat belts, a slightly tightened suspension and dual exhaust) to the *Bob Bondurant School of High Performance Driving* in Phoenix. Bondurant will start using *Cadillac CTs, Chevrolet Corvette Coupes* and *Z06s* in January on the school's 1.6-mile road course....*Bugatti* will build two *EB 16.4 Veyron supercars* per week maximum, which will be somewhere between 50 and 100 per year, said Bugatti Automobiles President Karl-Heinz Neumann. "*Each car will be priced at approximately \$1 million dollars at current exchange rates, exclusive of value added tax.*" Equipped with a *W16 8.0-liter, quad-turbo engine*, a concept of the EB 16.4

Veyron was shown at the October 1999 Tokyo auto show. *Volkswagen* bought the *Bugatti* trademark in June 1998, reportedly for a cool \$15 mil (!)...*Danbury Mint* is releasing a 1961 *Corvette* 1/24th scale diecast replica. It is white with silver coves and a red interior, and has features consistent with other 'Mint' diecasts: *opening doors, hood, and trunk, steerable wheels, and a lift-off hardtop.* The *trunk mat, tire cover, and genuine rubber spare tire* are also *removable*. It's only \$112, payable in *four* monthly installments of \$28 (plus a total of \$7.80 shipping and handling). Their address is 47 Richards Avenue, Norwalk, CT 06857....The following comes from the *GTR Modelers newsletter*, who actually had someone at the hobby show last month. From *AMT/ERTL*, they report that we will again see the *Lotus Turbine wedge car*; from *Fujimi*, an *all-new tool* of an

*AC Cobra* (!!); from *Tamiya*, a *Honda Fit van*, the *Enzo Ferrari*, a *tuner Nissan 350Z*, and rumors of a 2002 *Ferrari F1 car*, as well as a 1/12th scale 'Tribute' car(!); from *Testors*, a 1/6th scale 327 *multimedia* (plastic/metal) *engine kit*, and a new 1/24th scale 1969 *Charger R/T*, along with some *pre-painted tuner kits* of *Hondas, Acuras, and Mitsubishi's*. And from the rumor mill? *Testors* is rumored to be working on a *new line of true match factory car model colors*; *Maisto* is committing themselves to the US diecast market with *several US subjects* in the near future; and, last but certainly not least, *Hot Wheels* apparently has some *Batman items* headed our way. *Thanks, guys!* ....*More kit news!* This time from the *Hobby Heaven message board*, of a 1960 *Ford Sunliner convertible* included on *ERTL's Buyer's Choice* list for *March of 2003!*....*GM* confirmed it *will build an all-new 7.5-liter V12 for*

*use in an unspecified future Cadillac.* It will have an *aluminum block and cylinder heads, double overhead camshafts and four valves per cylinder.* And while GM promises its *all-aluminum V12* will produce *at least 500 hp*, so far, the *engine fits in just one of Cadillac's current vehicles*, the *Escalade* sport utility vehicle (*what else is new?!).* Cadillac was the last GM division to offer a V12, back in the 1930s....*Hooters wings clipped! Vanguard Airlines, Inc.* recently rejected an offer from the Hooters chairman to buy the bankrupt company as inadequate.... *Penske racing* recently confirmed their switch to *Dodge* for 2003... *Ford Motor Co.* announced that *Freestyle* will be the name of its *new crossover vehicle* that will debut in 2004....An all-new *Mercury Monterey minivan* (a *re-badged Windstar*) will go on sale in the near future, replacing the *Mercury Villager*. 🚗

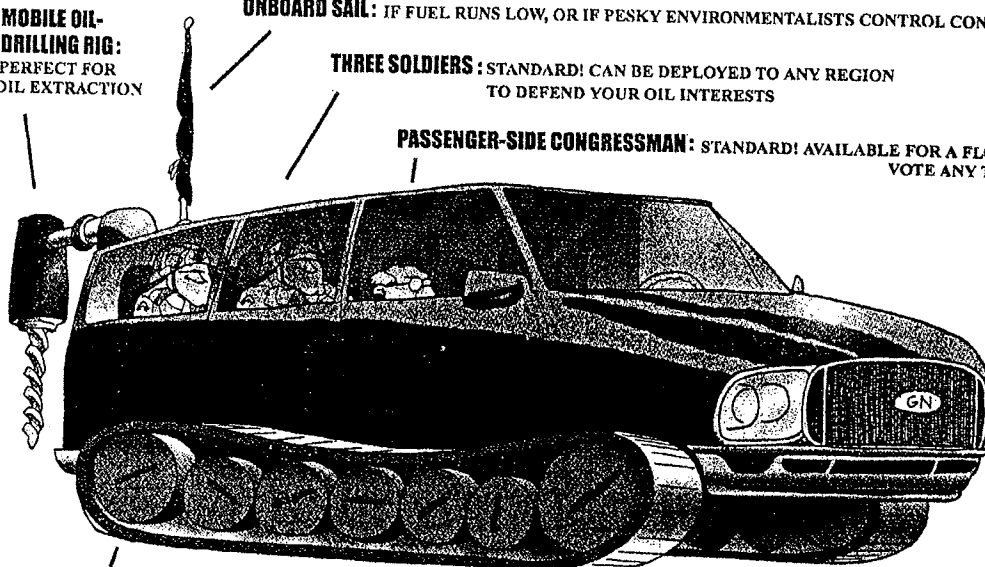

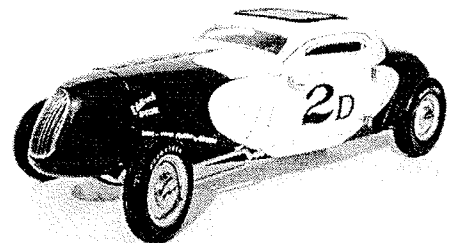

## New Websites

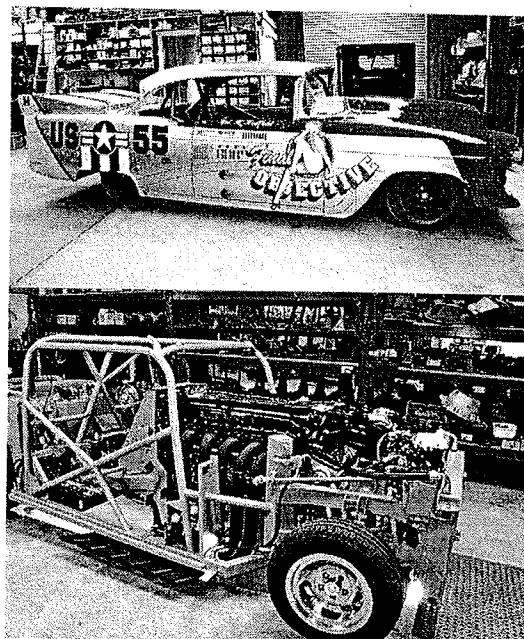

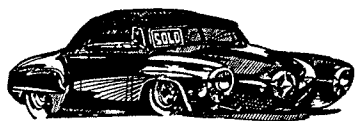

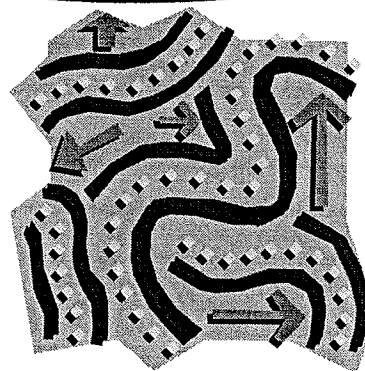

## Directions

**From the Baltimore Beltway (RT 695):** Take Exit 7, Route 295 (Baltimore-Washington Parkway) south towards Washington approx. 18 miles to Route 193 (Greenbelt Road), and exit. When on the off-ramp, stay to the right and merge right onto Southway (see below).

**From the Washington Beltway (RT 495):** Take Exit 22 north, towards Baltimore. Stay in the right lane and take the first exit onto Route 193 (Greenbelt Road). When on the off-ramp, bear to the right and take Greenbelt road west, towards College Park. Stay in the right lane and immediately after passing over the Parkway, make a right (at the light) onto Southway (read on!)



**Once on Southway:** Go straight to the second (2nd) STOP sign. Make a left onto Crescent road. Go to the STOP sign and make a right into the parking lot behind the Greenbelt Library. Once in parking lot, look to the right. The large, white building is the Greenbelt Community Center. Enter building using the doors near fenced tot lot. The multi-purpose room is on the second floor. There is an elevator to the left of the entrance. 🚗
