ide system, rollbar, 17inch wheels, side exhaust and Baer brakes starting at \$80,000. An all-out performance version goes for \$120,000!





He circled the pole and then headed south, A twinkle in his eye, and a smile on his mouth. And we heard him exclaim at a hundred miles an hour.



ing, and eventually the owner stuck his head out, soaking wet.



## **Off Road Madness**

In summer 2003. the U.S. will get a steady trickle of hot little Subaru WRX STi cars (as many as 4,000) from Japan starting at around \$35,000 *(?!)* apiece.

Boost from the straight-inlet IHI turbocharger (vs. 90-degree Mitsubishi unit on WRX) is increased on the

STi (Subaru Tecnica International) by mounting a larger intercooler to force greater amounts of dense, cooler air into the turbo, while the dual Suretrac limitedslip differentials are pulling all four wheels as hard as they can. Output from the flat four in this version is 261 hp (with 253 lb-ft of torque) in all non-Japanese-spec cars. (In Japan, horsepower is between 270 and 280 thanks in part to 100-plus-octane fuel). Talk about being 'pumped up!'

Ford will celebrate the 10th anniversary of its first Special Vehicle Team (SVT) car with a limited-edition SVT Mustang Cobra (coupe or convertible) in red, black or silver, that goes on sale next summer. It will be powered by a 4.6-liter, 390-horsepower, 32-valve supercharged V-8. Only 2,003 will be built. Other touches include 17inch dark argent-colored anniversary wheels, red leather seating surfaces, red brake calipers and SVT 10th Anniversary badges on floor mats and decklid.... Getting Focused! Apparently feeling left out by the impending release of the Dodge (Neon) SRT-4 (a 215hp turbo 2.4-liter pocket rocket), Ford has something called "Project Panama"-a turbocharged Ford Focus under development....YET ANOTHER Mustang! Roush Performance is introducing its Roush Classic, which shares the SVT Cobra mill. Well gang, with the release of the "Budweiser" Winston Cup car of Dale Earnhardt, Jr., the "Bud" dragster, and the "Coor's Light" Intrepid of Sterling Marlin, it looks as though at least one of the model manufacturers is trying to give us what we want! And, we won't run out and get drunk in celebration of the fact, either!

How do these kits compare with their 'sister' cars? Let's see!

As you would expect, the similarities are great in both kits. As far as the "Bud" rail is concerned, in comparing it to the "Pennzoil" rail which is the last rail I had purchased, the differences seem to be

limited to the new style intake scoop, the EVO-style front rims, the air intake, and, quite obviously, the "Budweiser" decals.

The "Coor's Light" Intrepid is based on the Bill Elliott Intrepid. The differences are limited to the presence of the 'barn doors' on the leading edge of the roof of Bill's Dodge, which are not mentioned on Sterling's car. Oh, and let's not forget the 'Adult Collectible' boldly emblazoned on both box lids, lest we forget our government's 'contribution!' It is also interesting to note that the "Coor's Light" and "Bud" kits are skill level 3, while Bill's Dodge

#### **Directions**

From the Baltimore Beltway RT 695): Take Exit 7, Route 295 (Baltimore-Washington Parkway) south towards Washington approx. 18 miles to Route 193 (Greenbelt Road), and exit. When on the offramp, stay to the right and merge right onto Southway (see below).

From the Washington Beltway (RT 495): Take Exit 22 north, towards Baltimore. Stay in the right lane and take the first exit onto Route 193 (Greenbelt Road). When on the off-ramp, bear to the right and take Greenbelt road west, towards College Park. Stay in the right lane and immediately after passing over the Parkway, make a right (at the light) onto Southway (read on!)



Once on Southway: Go straight to the second (2nd) STOP sign.

Make a left onto Crescent road. Go to the STOP sign and make a right into the parking lot behind the Greenbelt Library. Once in parking lot, look to the right. The large, white building is the Greenbelt Community Center. Enter building using the doors near fenced tot lot. The multi-purpose room is on the second floor. There is an elevator to the left of the entrance.
