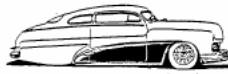

We are an informal group of automotive enthusiasts dedicated to the hobby of collecting and building scale model cars, trucks, and other wheeled vehicles. We are interested in friendship, the exchange of ideas, meeting and helping other modelers, getting people interested in the hobby (*or back into it*), and in general, promoting model car building and collecting.

## Where and when do we meet?

We typically meet on the third Saturday of the month, at the SEA Union Hall, 1300 Hanover Road, Hanover, MD 21076 from 10 AM to 2 PM.

## What do we do?

Besides attempting to build as many models as possible between monthly meetings, we gather and talk about models, diecasts, and automotive items of interest. No contests—just bring ‘em and show ‘em. Meetings are occasionally highlighted by building clinics or talks on various aspects of the hobby. Club funds are raised by way of a monthly raffle of model kits and related items donated by members and various outside sources, supplemented by a “door box” for small contributions.



## What does it take to become a member?

Simply attend a meeting, and enjoy yourself. There are no dues or fees to trifle with.

## What have we accomplished?

Our group has an abundance of talent; many of them have either been recognized in automotive modeling magazines, or authored articles for them. We produce a monthly newsletter that is available to club members, local hobby shops, kit manufacturers, model magazines, aftermarket suppliers, and other model car clubs throughout the nation. An address and phone number listing of all regular attendees is available to promote communication between club members between meetings for support and advice. We have also established a national level annual model car show and swap meet. It originated at the Orchard Beach Volunteer Fire Department, but quickly outgrew the facility. It is now held at the Level Volunteer Fire Company, 3633 Level Village Road, Havre de Grace, MD 21078. We are also active in the annual Toys for Tots drives in our area, and have supported the International Model Car

Builder’s Hall of Fame. If you like wheeled vehicles (*diecast or plastic*), please, do come and check us out. But be forewarned: Our main goal is to have a good time, and we do!
